

BIBLE TEACHING

Grades 4-6

(IN-HOUSE JUDGING will be held on Wednesday, February 8th)

PURPOSE

This Festival area provides students an opportunity to develop organizational and teaching skills for God's use.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Participants will prepare and teach a Bible lesson. The lesson must be based on a Bible character, a Bible doctrine or a Bible concept taught in scripture.
2. All lessons **MUST BE ORIGINAL** and cannot be taken from any published or unpublished sources. Reference materials may be used for background and explanatory material.
3. The lesson should be **three to six minutes** in length.
4. The lesson should be prepared for a class of primary age children, ages six to eight.
5. The lesson may include some type of audio/visual aid. The aids do not need to be original. If electronic aids are used, the student must indicate what is needed on a sheet attached to the Participation Form.
6. Participants must submit three copies of the lesson outline at the time of the Festival judging.
7. The outline must include
 - a. Objectives of the lesson
 - b. Specific principles(s) to be taught
 - c. Scripture reference(s)
 - d. Materials required
 - e. Brief summary of the lesson
 - f. Bibliography of references
