1. Choose 4 books to read this summer. Try to choose a variety. Example: One fiction, one non-fiction, a Christian novel, sports, science fiction, fantasy, biography, etc.
2. These books should be chapter books and at least 100 pages.
3. After reading each book, fill out a short summary form on the 4 chosen books.
4. If you read more than four books, please list the ones you read for Bonus Points.
5. This should be turned in to your 4th grade teacher or the 5th grade teacher the first week of school.

Parents, please look over carefully the books your child is choosing to read over the summer and will use in filling out the book report forms. We would love to see some of the choices be Christian themed, such as Christian biographies or Christian fiction.

The books need to be on 4th or 5th grade level. They should be at least 100 pages of chapter book reading.

With your approval, your child is encouraged to read : Christian fiction, Non-fiction, Historical fiction, Fantasy/folklore, or just interesting fiction. Suggested books would be the older Newberry award winners and other award winner books. Please read over the worksheet that is attached to help in choosing appropriate books.
